

The Prince's Drawing School *Postgraduate Programme*



“The Drawing Year”— a unique opportunity for intensive research and practice in drawing.

We provide an extensive one and two year postgraduate programme of practical taught classes supported by lectures, seminars and theoretical debate.

Why are we needed?

It is recognised both within the art world and in tertiary education that the teaching of drawing from observation is under threat for a complexity of reasons. We are not so much seeking to reverse the trend as to widen the choice for today's students, to give them an experience of drawing teaching at the highest level, and to provide encouragement if they choose to work figuratively or from observation.

How are we different?

We are a completely independent, non-profit art school which aims to raise the standard and profile of drawing through teaching and practice. We are the only institution in the UK committed to the practice of drawing from observation, with dedicated life studios, open six days and four evenings a week, offering a range of courses for all ages.

How does it work?

Our postgraduate programme, “The Drawing Year”, is an MA level course with a postgraduate diploma certificate that extends over one academic year. It offers thirty students the opportunity to explore a wide range of drawing practices. Bursary funded with free studio space in the Tea Building and ten further maintenance grants, students are also assessed by an Independent Board. The second year, which requires re-application, is designed to allow students to develop their personal studio practice in whatever medium they choose.

Applicants will usually have completed a BA degree in Fine Art or a related subject, but this is not essential. Applicants fill out a form, submit a portfolio of work and should be prepared to be interviewed if short listed. The application deadline is usually in April.
